

## MARTIME PAINT HORSE CLUB FUTURITY RULES

1. The following futurities will be offered by the Maritime Paint Horse Club in 2017. These futurities are only open to registered American Paint Horses:
  - a. **Weanling Halter Futurity (\$250)** – *MPHC Southern NB Show (Sept 2-3, 2017) - 2 judges*
  - b. **Yearling Halter Futurity (\$250)** – *MPHA Summer Splash Show (July 15-16, 2017) & MPHC Southern NB Show (Sept 2-3, 2017) - 4 judges, 2 at each show*
  - c. **Yearling Longe Line Futurity (\$250)** – *MPHA Summer Splash (July 15-16, 2017) & MPHC Southern NB Show (Sept 2-3, 2017) - 4 judges, 2 at each show*
  - d. **2 Yr Old Longe Line Futurity (\$250)** – *MPHA Summer Splash (July 15-16,2017) & MPHC Southern NB Show (Sept 2-3, 2017) – 4 judges, 2 at each show*
  - e. **Hunter Under Saddle Futurity (\$250)** – *MPHA Summer Splash (July 15-16, 2017) & MPHC Southern NB Show (Sept 2-3, 2017) - 4 judges, 2 at each show*
  - f. **Western Pleasure Futurity (\$250)** – *MPHA Summer Splash (July 15-16 2017) & MPHC Southern NB Show (Sept 2-3, 2017) - 4 judges, 2 at each show*
2. Futurity entries must be mailed to: **Shonda Wilson, 252 Ammon Road, Ammon NB, E1G 3N8. Please add the class number to the entry form for that show.**
3. Entry fees are \$20 per judge for the Yearling Halter, Yearling Longe Line, 2 Year Old Longe Line, Hunter Under Saddle, and Western Pleasure futurities. The entry deadline for these futurities is **July 1st, 2017 ( for the first set of judges)**. Entries will be accepted after JULY 1<sup>st</sup> at an increased cost of \$30 per judge. The second set of judges the deadline is AUGUST 17<sup>th</sup> and after that it will be \$30.00 per judge.
4. Entry fees are \$20 per judge for the Weanling Halter. The entry deadline for these futurities is **August 19, 2016**. Entries will be accepted after August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at an increased cost of \$30 per judge.
5. Futurity payouts are as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> – 38%, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 22%, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 15%, 4<sup>th</sup> – 11%, 5<sup>th</sup> – 8%, 6<sup>th</sup> – 6%. Ribbons will be awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place in each futurity and each futurity winner will receive an embroidered championship award. Money will be withheld from all fees to cover the cost of the championship award.
6. All placings are final and each futurity entry must **enter and show** in their regular respective class **at EACH show attended applicable to that futurity** (APHA open, APHA amateur, or APHA youth) in order to qualify. Exhibitors are **not** required to show in all rounds of the futurity itself in order to qualify. For example, a horse may compete in the Western Pleasure futurity

at the MPHSC Southern NB Show only as long as the futurity entry paperwork and payment are received prior to the day of the class.

7. Futurity results will be calculated based on the placings of all applicable judges – two at the MOHA Summer Splash Show in Windsor , NS (July 15-16) and two at the MPHSC Southern New Brunswick Show in Sussex, NB (September 2-3).
8. Points earned in each futurity under each judge will be calculated according to the table shown below. Placings will be announced for each judge after each round. The show secretary will calculate the final overall placings and these will be announced at the MPHSC Southern NB Show in September. If the overall scores result in a tie, a tie-breaking judge will be used. A coin toss will be conducted to determine the tie-breaking judge for 2017.

9. If a horse is disqualified in any round of the futurity this will not affect the number of entries in the class or the points earned but the disqualified horse will not receive any points for his/her round. For example, if there are three horses in the futurity and one is disqualified, the first place horse will receive 3 points, the second place horse will receive 2 points and the disqualified horse will receive no points.
10. All horses except unregistered weanlings must have a numbered APHA regular or solid-bred registration certificate. A photocopy of the registration certificate must accompany the futurity entry form (except for unregistered weanlings – in which case a copy of **both** the sire & dam's papers are required).
11. **BOTH the horse owner and exhibitor (if different) showing in Maritime Paint Horse Club Futurities MUST be current members in good standing with the club.**
12. All payout cheques will be mailed to the registered owner of the horse within 14 days after the September show.

13. In the event that an exhibitor is unable to attend the show, refunds of futurity fees will only be given if a signed veterinarian's certificate or doctor's note can be provided.
14. The Maritime Paint Horse Club reserves the right to cancel these futurities without notice and without liability at any time prior to the contest. In this case, all entry monies will be refunded.
