## **MARITIME PAINT HORSE CLUB SHOW RULES & INFORMATION**

1. Entries close **July 4, 2014** otherwise they will be considered late entries and charged accordingly. This rule will be strictly enforced.
2. Anyone wishing to compete in Western Horse Association of PEI classes (shown in yellow) must fill out the WHA entry form. This MPHC form is only to be used by exhibitors wishing to show APHA and MPHC classes (shown in blue). Only one stall fee and one trailer hookup fee will be charged for exhibitors showing classes held by both organizations. All other fees are organization specific and must be paid to the proper organization.
3. **THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.** A coin toss will determine the tie breaking judge in the event of any ties.
4. Full payment must accompany the entry forms. **Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.** Please make cheques payable to **"Maritime Paint Horse Club"**. NSF cheques will be subject to a \$50 handling fee.
5. APHA class fee: \$10.00 per class per judge or \$55.00 per double combination per judge (open/amateur; open/youth).
6. **APHA classes and MPHC Futurities are only open to registered Paints.** Horses must be registered with the American Paint Horse Association to compete in these classes and a photocopy of the registration papers must accompany the entry form (with the exception of unregistered weanlings) or the entry will not be processed for any APHA or MPHC classes. In the case of unregistered weanlings, a copy of both the sire and dam's papers are required.
7. All horses must be entered in the name of the owner listed on the registration papers.
8. Stalls are reserved on a first come, first serve basis with **NO** exceptions. Stalls are \$25 per night or \$45 per weekend. Stalls may only be reserved by filling out the attached stall/trailer hookup reservation form and sending it to Tina Arsenault-Bernard. **NOTE: Payment for stalls MUST be made to the Western Horse Association of PEI when you send in the form.**
9. There are 12 trailer hookups with water and electrical at a cost of \$15 per night or \$25 per weekend. These are reserved on a first come, first serve basis with **NO** exceptions. Trailer hookups may only be reserved by filling out the attached stall reservation/trailer hookup form and sending it to Tina Arsenault-Bernard. There are camping spaces available without water and electrical at no charge. **NOTE: Payment for trailer hookups MUST be made to the Western Horse Association of PEI when you send in the form.**
10. Bedding **MUST** be reserved by filling out the attached stall reservation/trailer hookup form and sending it to Tina Arsenault-Bernard. Bedding is sold at a cost of \$7 per bag. **NOTE: Payment for bedding MUST be made to the Western Horse Association of PEI when you send in the form**
11. Horses may arrive any time **after** 1pm on Friday, July 18. If anything is set up prior to this time you will be charged for an extra day.
12. Entry forms and the liability waiver **MUST** be signed by the exhibitor, or in the case of a youth, by the parent or guardian **BEFORE** the entry will be processed and a ring number is issued.
13. Insurance is **MANDATORY** (NBEA, NSEF, etc.) Proof of insurance (for both the horse owner and the exhibitor if different) must accompany the entry forms.
14. **One entry form per horse/rider combination INCLUDING LEADLINE exhibitors** is required (example: if both Johnny and Janie will be showing Patches, two entry forms are required – one for Johnny & Patches and one for Janie & Patches). Please note there will only be one APHA processing fee and horse fee in this case.

15. Only one ring number will be issued **per horse** regardless of the number of exhibitors showing the horse.
16. If an exhibitor requests the use of their own back number and there is a duplicate request, the numbers will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis.
17. Hay and feed will not be available for sale at the show.
18. The show office will be open Friday evening from 5:00pm to 8:00pm and opens Saturday morning at 7:00am and Sunday morning at 7:00am. Please have your forms filled out properly before entering the show office.
19. Post entries will be accepted the day of the show at an **additional \$3.00** per class per judge (total of \$13 per class per judge) but the show secretary **must** be notified a minimum of 3 classes prior to a horse entering the ring for a class that is not on the original entry form. This rule will be strictly enforced as we are on a tight time schedule.
20. All questions or concerns must be directed to the show manager, Jodi Smith, who will be on-site for the duration of the weekend.
21. All APHA classes and MPHC Futurities are walk/trot(jog)/canter(lope) with the **exception** of APHA Youth Walk Trot – ages 5 to 10, which is walk/trot(jog) only.
22. This show is APHA approved and **all APHA** classes will follow the rules of the Official APHA Rule Book. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to know the rules.** The current year rule book can be requested from the American Paint Horse Association or accessed at: <http://www.apha.com/forms/rule-books>
23. All APHA class exhibitors must hold a valid APHA membership card. A photocopy of the membership card must accompany the entry form. MPHC will not have the ability to check memberships online at the show.
24. APHA Amateur exhibitors (ages 19 & over) must hold a valid APHA amateur card. A photocopy of the amateur card must accompany the entry form. MPHC will not have the ability to check memberships online at the show.
25. If an exhibitor holds an APHA Amateur Walk-Trot card, the only classes they are permitted to enter are halter, showmanship, and longe line.
26. APHA Youth exhibitors (ages 18 & under) must hold a valid APHA youth card. A photocopy of the youth card must accompany the entry form. MPHC will not have the ability to check memberships online at the show.
27. Exhibitor ages will be based on the age as at January 01, 2014 and are broken down as follows (date of birth must appear on the entry form):
  - APHA Walk/Trot – ages 5 to 10
  - APHA Youth – ages 18 & under
  - APHA Amateur – ages 19 & over
  - APHA Leadline – ages 3 to 8
28. For APHA classes, a “junior” or “senior” classification is based on the age of the horse.
29. No stallions are permitted to compete in APHA Youth classes. Stallions may only be shown by **senior** exhibitors (ages 19 & over) with the exception of **APHA open** classes in which case the exhibitor **must** still be at least 16 years of age.
30. In the event that an exhibitor is unable to attend the show, a full refund of **entry and stall fees** will be given with the **EXCEPTION** of the horse fee. Refunds will be paid after the show as long as **written** notice is given.
31. MPHC recommends that you have your horse vaccinated.

32. For insurance purposes, all horses must have a stall (no tying to trailers allowed).
33. Any act deemed as abusive towards an animal or individual will be investigated according to the rules outlined in the APHA rule book.
34. **SPLITTING & COMBINING CLASSES (APHA classes only):** per the APHA rulebook, show management may combine or split age groups as justified by entries if there is a unanimous consent of all involved exhibitors, **however, if one division is not a point earning class, then show management may combine age groups, without unanimous consent of all exhibitors, in order to make the division a point earning class.**
35. Trail competitors will have three attempts at each obstacle. If unsuccessful, a whistle will signal you to move on to the next obstacle. If three obstacles are not completed successfully, the whistle will blow twice signaling you to leave the ring.
36. Proper attire as per the official APHA rule book must be worn in all classes.
37. Exhibitor's numbers must be worn and visible at all times.
38. Exhibitors are responsible to **BE READY WHEN THE CLASS IS CALLED**. You will be given three advance calls, if you are not ready at the time of the third call you will be disqualified from the class.
39. The sponsors, organizing committee, and show staff do not assume any responsibility for accidents or illness to horses, attendants, riders, spectators, or any other person on the property or for the loss of, or damage to, any equipment or personal belongings while attending the show.
40. **MPHC members** can qualify for the following year end awards (**NOTE: BOTH the horse owner and the exhibitor (if different) MUST be members in good standing with the MPHC to qualify for these awards**). Awards will be determined by total points accumulated at both the PEI and the Sussex shows:
  - High Point & Reserve High Point Amateur (includes all APHA amateur regular registry or solid bred classes except Grand and Reserve Halter Classes)
  - High Point & Reserve High Point Youth (includes all APHA youth regular registry or solid bred classes)
  - High Point & Reserve High Point Open (includes all APHA open regular registry or solid bred classes except Grand and Reserve Halter classes and MPHC Futurities)
  - High Point & Reserve High Point Overall Solid Bred Horse (includes all APHA solid bred classes – amateur, youth & open except Grand and Reserve Halter classes and MPHC Futurities)
  - High Point & Reserve High Point Overall Regular Registry Horse (includes all APHA regular registry classes – amateur, youth & open except Grand and Reserve Halter classes and MPHC Futurities)
  - High Point & Reserve High Point Versatility (includes hunter under saddle, western pleasure, trail & reining – APHA open classes, either regular registry or solid bred) – **NOTE: You MUST compete in at least 3 of the 4 classes on EACH day at EACH show to be eligible for this award**
  - MPHC Youth Rookie Award (includes all APHA youth regular registry or solid bred classes)

## MARTIME PAINT HORSE CLUB FUTURITY RULES

1. The following futurities will be offered by the Maritime Paint Horse Club in 2014:
  - a. Weanling Halter Futurity (\$250) – *Sussex, NB show only*
  - b. Yearling Halter Futurity (\$250)
  - c. Yearling Longe Line Futurity (\$250)
  - d. 2 Year Old Walk/Trot Futurity (\$250 – open to both English & Western Horses) – *Sussex, NB show only*
  - e. Hunter Under Saddle Futurity (\$250)
  - f. Trail Futurity (\$250)
  - g. Western Pleasure Futurity (\$250)
2. **ALL** entries must be mailed to: **Sarah Weeks, 91 Pipertown Road, Summerville NB, E5S 1E6**
3. Entry fees are \$80 for the Yearling Halter, Yearling Longe Line, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, and Western Pleasure futurities and this covers all go-rounds for both the Summer Color Show in PEI and the Southern New Brunswick Show in Sussex. The entry deadline for these futurities is **July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2014**. No late entries will be accepted. \$100 will be withheld from each futurity to cover the cost of the championship jacket. All entry money will be added to the pot and paid out on a percentage basis.
4. Entry fees are \$40 for the Weanling Halter and 2 Year Old Walk/Trot futurities and this covers both go-rounds at the Southern New Brunswick Show in Sussex. The due date for these futurities is **August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2014**. No late entries will be accepted. \$100 will be withheld from each futurity to cover the cost of the championship jacket. All entry money will be added to the pot and paid out on a percentage basis.
5. Futurity payouts are as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> – 38%, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 22%, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 15%, 4<sup>th</sup> – 11%, 5<sup>th</sup> – 8%, 6<sup>th</sup> – 6%. Ribbons will be awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place in each futurity and each futurity winner will receive an embroidered championship jacket.
6. All placings are final and each futurity entry must enter their regular respective class **on EACH day at EACH show applicable to the futurity** (APHA open, APHA amateur, or APHA youth) in order to qualify.
7. Futurity results will be calculated based on the placings of all applicable judges – two at the Summer Color Show in Crapaud, PEI and two at the Southern New Brunswick Show in Sussex, NB. **NOTE: You must compete in all go-rounds to qualify unless a signed veterinarian's certificate can be provided.**
8. Points earned in each futurity under each judge will be calculated according to the table shown in the Show Rules & Information. Placings will be announced for each judge after each round. The show secretary will calculate the final overall placings and these will be announced on Sunday, August 31<sup>st</sup> as the Southern NB Show in Sussex. If the overall scores result in a tie, the tie-breaking judge will be used. A coin toss will be conducted on Sunday morning at the Southern NB Show to determine the tie-breaking judge for 2014.
9. All horses except unregistered weanlings must have a numbered APHA regular or solid-bred registration certificate. A photocopy of the registration certificate must accompany the futurity entry form (except for unregistered weanlings – in which case a copy of both the sire & dam's papers are required).

10. **BOTH** the horse owner and exhibitor (if different) showing in Maritime Paint Horse Club Futurities **MUST** be current members in good standing with the club.
11. All payout cheques will be mailed to the registered owner of the horse within 14 days after the Sussex show.
12. The Maritime Paint Horse Club reserves the right to cancel these futurities without notice and without liability at any time prior to the contest. In this case, all entry monies will be refunded.
